



GENEVA CABLE WAKE INTERNATIONAL OPEN: FORMAT OF THE COMPETITION

Art1: The Cable Wake International Open (CWIO) is organized by the Wake Sport Center (WSC) and is the opportunity to see some of the best Cablewake riders of Europe and in the World. The event is located in downtown Geneva, Switzerland.

Art2: The event organizer (WSC) invites “nation-team” and chooses a captain that selects 3 riders for the competition. The captain can also be a rider. Each “nation-team” can have a maximum of one foreign rider in the team and receives an invitation and a budget for their expenses to travel to Geneva. All the riders are qualified directly for the half-final. All the costs of the invited riders are taken by the Wake Sport Center while doing the competition (including lodging).

Art3: For the Swiss Team, there is one foreign rider that is invited by the Wake Sport Center and 2 Swiss riders that will be selected through the qualification which will take place Friday from 8 am to 12 pm the 26th of June. There is no fee to do the competition. A minimum of skills can be asked to attend the qualification.

Art4: Each captain can present judges. Two will be selected by the organizer of the event.

Art5: The event is organized in two parts: 1) the competition itself and 2) the shows

Art6: The format of the competition is the following:

- 1) Friday 26th of June from 1 pm to 9 pm training
- 2) Saturday 27th of June from 9 am to 12 pm: Half final
- 3) Sunday 28th of June from 10 am to 12 pm: Final best of 6

The Wakecable is a Sesitec 2.0 of 191m. It has two kickers and 1 rail of 18m.

The detail of the rules will be given by the judges at the riders briefing that will be held at 8.30 am Saturday the 26th of June. All the riders have to be present.



Art7: The format of the shows is the following:

- 1) Saturday 27th of June from 3pm to 10 pm
- 2) Sunday 28th of June from 3pm to 4pm for the first 3 riders of the competition

There will be an additional pontoon boat that will have a Wall type of slider mounted to it. The exact format will be discussed during the lunch on Saturday.

Art8: Team Ranking & Prize

The Team Cup will be given to the best “nation team”. It will be the addition of the result of the 3 riders of the team in the qualification run of Saturday.

The Cup will be distributed Saturday at 8 pm.

Art9: Individual Ranking & Prizes

The prizes will be distributed Sunday at 2pm. The 6 riders of the final receive a prize. For the first 3 riders there will be also a prize money.

- First place: CHF 1'500.-
- Second place: CHF 600.-
- Third place: CHF 300.-

Art10: Cameras, drones filming rights

This event will be filmed by cameras and drones. TV will also come. All rights of filming belongs to the Wake Sport Center. The films will be freely available on the web.
